Practice

Ability to configure options to display/not display After visit Summary and Check-out Date




DrCloudEHR now provides the option to display/not display the "After Visit Summary" and "Check-Out Date" on the New Encounter Form based on the global settings - "Hide After Visit Summary Section at new encounter" and "Hide the Check-Out Date field at new encounter". Please contact DrCloudEHR Client Services to update your agency's configuration.

The Encounter Summary view loads much faster now




DrCloudEHR now displays the forms in an encounter in a list by default in the Encounter Summary view to load the Encounter Summary quickly. Click the new "Preview" button to view the form. Please contact DrCloudEHR Client Services to have this setting updated for your agency if needed.



A new Comment field is available when adding a New Patient



DrCloudEHR now includes a **"Comment field"** in the admit section when adding a New Patient. Comments will be saved and displayed on Admit/Discharge page in the comments field in the admin section.






New Service Rules Module to assign actions to take before providing services




DrCloudEHR now includes the option to create specific "Service Rules" in the Service Rules Module at Practice

Administrative.



Users can define a rule for each code with specific criteria including insurance, facility, units allowed, number of occurrences, etc. These rules are then applied when creating an appointment, encounter, adding a code (encounter, fee sheet, forms), and billing. E.g., preventing a 3rd appointment/session from occurring on the same day of service.






Changes to the Manage User Access screen

Core Setup

DrCloudEHR now includes the following changes in **Practice** → **Administrative** → **Programs**

- A. "Users Dropdown": Now displays the provider certification levels next to their names.
- B. Added a check box "Include Inactive Users" to filter inactive users. This is unchecked by default. Now authorized users can easily manage access for active users. They can manage access for inactive users by checking the box to display them.






Billing

Additional default search criteria option at Claims Manager

Core Setup

DrCloudEHR now includes a new setting "Default X12 Partner" with the options - All, Select, and X12 Partners list. The selected option will then be added to the default search criteria in the Claims Manager. When nothing is selected then, there is no change to the current system behavior.






Reports

Ability to view clients created in a given period



Reports → Clients → Clients List

DrCloudEHR now includes a new radio button "Client Creation" at Reports \rightarrow Clients \rightarrow Clients List. Using this option and selecting the required date range authorized users can list the patients that were created during that timeframe.





Third-party Modules

New Greenspace Outcomes Measurement Module available

DrCloudEHR now supports integration with Greenspace Mental Health's Measurement-based Care. Measurement-Based Care involves tracking client progress throughout treatment, using consistent Patient-Reported Outcome Measures (PROMS). Incident Report Module

Now users can report Incidents Anonymously

Core Setup

DrCloudEHR now supports anonymous Incident reporting. Authorized users can create an anonymous user by assigning the "Anonymous login Group" in User Administration. These users will only have access to the Patient Incidents screen to submit a clinical or non-clinical incident. They cannot view/edit/print an incident once it is submitted.
